SESP has been recognized as a Great Place to Work — an achievement that stands as a reflection of our shared values, trust, and teamwork.

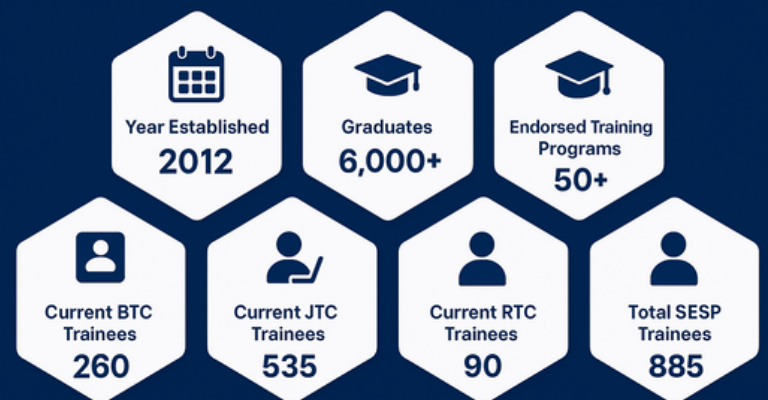
